

- After School fee is \$25.00 - please plan to pay (cash or check) when you pick your child up UNLESS another plan has been okayed
 - 3rd child of the same family will receive a reduced rate
- Hours - after school until 5:30 pm
- You are only billed for the days your child attends - if you don't send your child on a scheduled day and DON'T let me know a \$5.00 fee will be charged

- Attendance - is expected as scheduled or indicated through Drop In sign up. If you change your plan PLEASE send a text and let me know about the change
- If someone comes to pick up your child that is not on the permission list your child will not be able to go with them. Please give me notice that you have made a change so that I don't have to try to track you down at the last minute. Please let people know they will need to show identification (even if they are members of the family)
- If you are going to be late (after 5:30pm) please text to let me know
- Remember to let the school know your plans via Pick Up Patrol

- We serve snacks each afternoon. Foods vary from day to day. FOR SAFETY: If your child has a food allergy, please let me know. It also helps me know if we need special foods available

- We offer the opportunity for homework to be done each afternoon. If you want your child to do homework when with us, let me know and I will ensure it happens.
- If you would like to visit the program please let me know and we can make arrangements

- We follow the Harwich elementary School schedule.
 - If there is school, we are open
 - We are open for early release Wednesdays
 - We are open for half-days
- We are closed during school vacations

- You can schedule your child for 1 - 5 days a week. You can also register as a Drop In student.
 - Drop In = text or email me to add your child to the list for a specific day
 - You can let me know the day of drop in or earlier if you know
- You can schedule days AND add Drop In days as well.
- Once you have registered, your space is yours until the last day of school in June, regardless of how often it is used
