Commissioning of Pilgrim Church's Governance Task Force October 19, 2025

Dear friends, we recognize the ministry of the Governance Task Force and commission them to this special task in the service of Jesus Christ.

The people in our church are enthusiastic, dedicated and faithful. Together, we can focus our energy and creativity. The goal of the Governance Task Force is to gain clarity and unity around how to best use our finite resources of time, energy and money and put them where they function best and have the most impact within our sphere of influence, our part of God's kindom. Over the next months, the Governance Task Force will work to identify a more streamlined and nimble governance structure for Pilgrim Church. They will evaluate our current structure: solicit feedback from church leadership, committees and members to learn what currently works well, as well as to identify the limitations and challenges. They will research governance innovation, learning from various resources. They will propose a new model, which will be vetted through the congregational process. Pilgrim Church will then set a trial period during which we will "test drive" the new model, receiving feedback along the way... repeating as necessary. Ultimately, once a new governance model is successfully in place for a sufficient period of time, the Pilgrim Church Bylaws will be updated to reflect the new structure.

The Task Force will need the prayers of the whole congregation, as well as our encouragement and participation along the way.

For today, we are asking your blessing as we commission this group to their work. Will the Governance Task Force members please come forward?

Barbara, Barbara, Bruce, Bud, Heidi, Laurie, and Molly, do you promise to prayerfully and faithfully do the work set before you? Will you endeavor to listen carefully and remain open to the Holy Spirit's leading?
